Member Interview

Dori Stickles

This month, I'd like to introduce another new member of the LAA Board of Directors. Her name is Dori Stickles. You may remember some of the award-winning watercolor paintings she has entered into LAA shows. One of those was of raspberries that looked so real, you wanted to pick them up and eat them off her painting!

Dori grew up as one of seven children. For her first 9 years, her Navy family moved every two years, requiring the siblings to learn resilience, adaptability, and what it can be like being the "new kid." A coping strategy for Dori was her creativity, born from daydreaming a lot. When she was 17, Dori's mother passed away. At 18, she enlisted in the Navy and started taking courses, including art, at a community college near where she was stationed on Whidbey Island, Washington. After her four year stint in the Navy, Dori lived near Seattle and there she met her



husband. After her two sons were born, Dori and her husband decided they needed to be near their families, so they moved to Maryland in 1991. Both had come from the east coast originally.

As a young mother with two small children, Dori started a home daycare business which allowed her to earn some money while tending her own kids, and to engage her young charges in some fun art projects. Once her own children were school age, Dori resumed her education at Towson University in Towson, Maryland, completing her BA and then her MA degrees to prepare for public school teaching. She became a secondary school art teacher, which allowed her to continue developing her own artistic skills while earning a living. The job afforded opportunities to teach and learn numerous art forms, including ceramics, graphic design, and beginning photography in addition to drawing and painting.

After 14 years of teaching, Dori's back pain became serious enough that she retired on disability status. Her two sons had moved here to Colorado, so in 2013, Dori followed suit. Since moving to Boulder, she has devoted herself to painting and further developing her artistic skills through study with local teachers such as Kathleen Lanzoni and the late Molly Davis. Dori prefers the studio to *en plein aire* painting, as she finds the many challenges of outdoor painting not a good fit for her approach. She considers her studio painting a form of meditation enhanced by privacy and music, and works from her own photographs. This approach is perfect

for Dori, as evidenced by the meticulous detail so competently rendered in each of her paintings. Her works have been in many local art shows and have won numerous awards, including a *Best in Show* for her painting Freshly Picked, a *Third Place* and a *People's Choice* for her painting Wonderland, and a *Second Place People's Choice* for her painting Verdant Chautauqua at the Nederland Community Center Art Show. As a member of Boulder's Open Studios program, Dori participated in the new Pearl St. Pop! Gallery over the holidays, and has had work in the R Gallery near Pearl St. Mall. While her subject matter is mostly landscapes and florals, Dori also paints other wonders of the natural world such as pet portraits, birds, butterflies, and rock formations. Dori has endured more than her share of losses in life, and as many of us know, healing from loss is a long-term process requiring many coping strategies. For Dori, these have been found in her art, hiking, and swimming, as well as her volunteering for the Humane Society, for a local youth mentoring program and now, for LAA as a member of the Board. Her quiet strength, rich knowledge and experience, and spirit of giving are of great benefit to LAA overall and to all of us who participate. - Jane Elvins
