Member Interview Ani Liggett

In case you don't know her, I want to introduce Ani Liggett, one of LAA's new Board members. Ani brings to the table an impressive set of credentials, a formidable list of skills, and fascinating personal and professional histories, all of which contribute to her value in this leadership position.

Ani grew up in New England, first in Providence, Rhode Island and later in rural Connecticut. She was one of five children, and her industrious father was an airplane mechanic, who built the family's beach house at the Rhode Island shore. Many family vacations and good memories are associated with that location. As a youngster, Ani dreamed of attending the prestigious Rhode Island School of Design, but that was not to be.... partly because she was a girl and partly because it wasn't affordable. Her hard-working mother advised Ani to " learn to type because someday you may have to support yourself." The family message was to not rise beyond her blue-collar origins. As she began her life's journey, Ani never took that to heart, but instead has followed her own interests every step of the way.



Ani started her higher education with an Associate's degree. Two years out of junior college, she ventured to Washington D.C. where she worked, met her future husband, married and had two sons. A series of tragic events resulted in the loss of her youngest son and, eventually, of her marriage. At age 30, she set out on a 3-month road trip with her then 6 year old son Brett, a canvas tent, a spirit of adventure and a courageous heart. They camped every night from coast to coast, eventually ending up in Aspen, where her son started first grade, never to return to the east coast.

In Aspen, Ani worked as Executive Secretary for the Aspen Chamber & Visitors' Bureau. Due to affordable housing shortages, she and Brett later moved to Boulder. While working for the next 8 years as Assistant to the Boulder City Council during an exciting period in Boulder politics, Ani earned her B.A. in Communication and a Masters in Public Administration, with a post-grad study in Organization Consulting. By this time, Ani found her interests had shifted to Human Psychology rather than large organizations. With her son launched, in 1983 she moved to California to study/work at Esalen Institute in Big Sur, then at Fielding Graduate University in Santa Barbara, earning a Ph.D. in clinical psychology. She had a private practice in Santa Cruz for ten years before feeling the pull to be back in Colorado and to be close to family. (Niwot's Curse?)

Once back in the area and licensed to practice in Colorado, she worked as a geriatric and pain management psychologist, and then opened a private practice specializing in mid-life women's transition based on her book. She bought a home in Lafayette and pursued art once again, studying watercolor with LAA's own Nancy Sullo. Through the years, Ani had dabbled in various art forms (batik, pastels, silk painting, urban sketching),

but her responsibilities as a self-supporting Mom took priority over her long-held desire to create art. Currently, she has a teacher/mentor in Kelly Folsom, learning oil painting in the chiaroscuro style, which produces a warm, old world charm in the eye of the viewer. Now retired, it is her time to develop as an artist, exploring her initial love of oil painting.

Currently, Ani is learning the business of art, specifically on-line marketing through her website <u>www.aniliggett.com</u>. After having five businesses on her own (two private therapy practices, a thermal window shade business, writing and self-publishing a book, and now art), Ani finds she enjoys being connected to a community of artists. She has been a member of LAA for about 12 years, and is now on LAA's Board of Directors!

Ani has continued to serve her community as a volunteer with the I Have a Dream Foundation, mentoring young girls from disadvantaged families. As a member of the Boulder Valley Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of Lafayette, she serves as a Lay Pastoral Care Associate, providing support to church members undergoing difficulties. And using her artistic talent, she serves on the Fellowships' aesthetics committee. In light of these commitments Ani fulfills, we in LAA are very fortunate to have her as a Board Member.
