Member Interview Sandy Price

We're honored this month to feature LAA's new President, Sandy Price! Sandy joined LAA five years ago with encouragement from her friend Sheila Fossen. Sandy was invited to join the Board of Directors in 2020. She was then elected as Treasurer and served until January 2022. The 2022 Board was completed when three members were added to replace those whose term ended. An election was held among Board members and Sandy became the new President to replace outgoing President Helen Harrison. Of course, Helen will be a tough act to follow, but Sandy is very capable. She is excited about the new



challenges she faces, and LAA is delighted to have her leadership.

Sandy was raised in a community northwest of Detroit, Michigan. As a girl, Sandy developed interests in woodworking while in a shop class, landscape design from helping and observing her father, art and photography. She fondly recalls her first camera, a little box-shaped Kodak Brownie with a viewfinder she looked down into, and a flash attachment on the side. Those beginning level interests grew and blossomed over the years, making them important forms of self-expression for Sandy as a retired adult.

At age 22, Sandy and her best friend followed a dream by moving to California. Living in the LA area, Sandy worked for Warner Brothers and loved spending time off around Venice Beach. After a few years, her friend got married and started a new life, so Sandy decided to explore her love of the mountains and outdoor life by moving to Colorado. Two years later, she got married and soon had three children. Unfortunately, the marriage didn't work out, putting Sandy in the difficult role of a single, working mom. In another couple of years, she met Dave Price who became her good friend as his two children from a previous relationship got to know Sandy's kids. When the time was right, Dave and Sandy got married, forming a blended family. Although combining families presented many challenges, all involved stayed the course, overcame the obstacles, and are today a strong, well-functioning, expanding family consisting of the original five children (now adults), their spouses, and a new generation of children, giving Sandy and Dave 9 beloved grandchildren. When the whole family gets together, there are 21 people (so far), making extra long tables necessary in order to seat everyone!

While her five children were growing up, Sandy decided to continue her education, earning needed credits where she could, and became qualified to teach at Maranatha Christian Center in Arvada. There she stayed for 15 years, teaching everything she was assigned, from junior high art to high school history. As an art teacher, Sandy revived her long-held interests in photography, art and woodworking. She introduced her students to many different forms of arts and crafts, while providing herself with opportunities to develop her own interests and skills. After 15 years, Sandy followed her principal to another position at Life Christian Academy in Westminster, where she taught for 5 more

years. By that time, her grandbabies had begun to appear and she made the conscious decision to retire from her career in order to care for them at home while parents worked. This devoted grandmother has cared for all 9 grandchildren from their infancy to when they became old enough to go to school.

Those years of caring for grandchildren included another opportunity for Sandy. She served as President of her Home Owners Association in Westminster and thoroughly enjoyed the challenges as well as the friendships that grew from her role. In October 2020, Sandy and Dave had decided to downsize, so they sold their big, family home and bought a suitably-sized condo in Broomfield. Sandy found she was very sad to resign from her HOA position because of the relationships forged during that period. Her feelings of loss were eased somewhat by finding a new art home in LAA, and by the opportunity to become more involved when invited to join the LAA Board of Directors as Treasurer.

Always an avid gardener, Sandy has gotten involved in numerous landscaping projects in the last 25 years for her HOA and church. She has designed and planted rock gardens and vegetable gardens. She has also been doing substantial remodeling work on the new home, bringing her established carpentry skills to the foreground again. She calls landscaping and remodeling "Giant Art," but watercolor is her favorite. And through all the stages of her adult life, Sandy has been a dedicated member of her church, being involved with its prison ministry, retreats, youth groups, and women's groups, seeing those as opportunities for her to serve others. Her faith is extremely important to her and she feels it has sustained her through all she has done. Currently, she is working with Samaritan's Purse to dig and sift through the rubble of homes burned in the Marshall Fire, looking for valuables to return to homeowners. Sandy and the group are chain-sawing and improving the land left behind.

Sandy looks forward to getting back into her arts, crafts and jewelry, and preparing to enter numerous shows coming up, including a big crafts market north of Steamboat Springs, where she and Dave have a mountain home. Sandy loves the mountains, being outdoors, hiking, biking, and riding her ATV! Her current term with LAA's Board runs through the end of 2022, at which time she hopes to be asked to continue. She says she's continually amazed at the level of involvement shown by LAA members. "So many people do so much!" is how she expressed it. **- Jane Elvins**
