

## SUGGESTED MATERIALS LIST

I would prefer you bring whatever you are most comfortable with, but you must have some version of

- a plein air easel
- solvent (Odorless mineral spirits for oil ,water for watercolor or acrylic)
- solvent container
- brushes and/or palette knife
- paint
- rag/paper towel
- pencil
- sketch pad
- palette
- plenty of canvas/paper (small size like 6x8 at least 6) Please do not bring paper or canvas larger than 9x12 unless you are more experienced and prefer that. I would suggest sticking with 6x8 in order that you can do more studies.
- bag or backpack.

If you are not sure what to bring here is a minimalist-ish list:

- Aluminum or steel tripod easel
- Gamsol (oil) or water (watercolor, acrylic)
- Brush cleaning tank
- Flat/filbert or round 2 #6, 2 #4, 2 #2, small palette knife
- 4 rags
- Palette
- Paint: Cadmium yellow light, permanent alizarin, ultramarine, phthalo green, yellow ocher, large titanium white
- #2 pencil 5x7 sketch pad
- 6-6x8 piece of canvas or paper taped to a board.
