Drew Austin (he/him, b.1996) is an interdisciplinary artist and curator living and working in Denver, CO. He grew up in Great Falls, Montana, and attended the Rocky Mountain College of Art + Design, in Denver, which he graduated from in 2017 with his BFA as Valedictorian

Austin is the Curator of Visual Arts at The Dairy Arts Center in Boulder, CO, where he exhibits the work of artists from all across the country (and sometimes the world) in their four rotating gallery spaces. He previously worked as the Exhibitions Curator for ReCreative Denver as well as put together independent curatorial projects in spaces such as Redline Denver, The Temple Artist Studios, The Digital Armory, and Alto Gallery.

Portrayed primarily through drawing, sculpture, and light-based installation, Austin's work functions as a conduit for understanding and comprehension of everyday things—mundane situations, domestic space, slow growth, and light—both large and small in a human-dominated world.

TO ENTER:

- Complete the registration online or mail the signed registration form.
- \$30 entry fee must be received by March 25th.
- Be an active LAA member with dues paid for 2024.
- Volunteer for two show related activities. (Link available thru the louisvilleart.org website).

WHAT YOU CAN ENTER:

- One 48-inch max. (longest side) framed piece
- OR Two 24-inch max. (longest side) framed pieces
- OR Two 3-D pieces
- OR One 24-inch (longest side) framed piece, plus one small 3-D piece

ARTWORK ACCEPTED:

Oil, Pastel, Watercolor, Acrylic, Mixed Media, Photography; 3D categories: Pottery, Sculpture, Glass, Jewelry; Other mediums: Encaustic, Drawing, Lithograph/Monoprint, Artist-pulled printmaking, Fiber Art, and Digital Painting

REQUIREMENTS FOR ARTWORK:

- All 2D Pieces must be framed or gallery wrapped with picture wire attached, ready to hang. See below for specs on gallery wrap. **NO sawtooth hangers, NO frameless glass framing. Pieces without hangers will not be hung**.
- Unframed canvases must be gallery wrapped. The canvas stretchers must be 1.25" thick minimum and the canvas must be attached to the back of the stretcher so it doesn't show when hung.
- All artwork may not be a reproduction or of copyrighted artwork. Giclee prints of traditional media may not be entered.
- Work shown in LAA Member Shows within the past two years will NOT be accepted.
- In addition to your piece(s) you may display any or all of the following (collectively called "Bin Work"). All bin work must be labeled and have a bin work inventory sheet.
 - ◆ Up to 5 pieces of matted and unframed bin work (max size of 36" on long edge, no piece thicker than 3/8"). NO framed art is allowed in freestanding bins. Bin artwork can be replenished as needed. (Please no crafts, glass pieces, jewelry, etc. as bin work)
 - ♦ 5 boxes of greeting or note cards
 - ◆ 10 individual cards (wrapped for individual sale)
- If you have bin work download the bin work inventory form from the LAA spring show webpage. Completed inventory form for bin work is required to check-in no exceptions.
- Each bin work item must have a price tag in the following format: Artist initials (Last, First, Middle) item number, price. The inventory form provides a detailed description for labeling your bin work. PLEASE READ and follow those directions.

- LAA will provide all bins and card racks. Please do not bring bins or card racks.
- An inventory form will be printed with your art entries and you will have to initial it at check in. Bring your bin inventory sheet with you. If you replenish your bin work be sure to add the replacement pieces to your Replacement Bin Inventory Sheet. The Bin Inventory Sheets are available on the website.
- Label all your artwork according to the standards on the registration form. List the exact outside dimensions of your framed/gallery wrapped artwork.

HOW TO SUBMIT:

Enter ONLINE by going to: https://louisvilleartassociation.org/member-shows/#spring-show and click the registration button.

Or MAIL your entry so it is RECEIVED by March 25. Make a check payable to Louisville Art Association, and note LAA Spring Member Show Entry.
